Champagne and Sparkling Wine by the Flute

Canella Prosecco, Italy - Clean, mild nose exhibiting a touch of citrus and mineral. In the mouth, bubbles are coarse, flavor is clean with some salty mineral. There is enough acidity to match fairly well with food. Citrusy fruit, light body, easy drinking, simple and short but pleasing finish. \$11

La Marca Prosecco, Italy - A delicate, well-balanced Prosecco, showing a good blend of baked apple, sour lemon and grapefruit, with a lightly creamy mineral texture on the palate. Medium froth, with some body and a pleasant lemon and mineral finish. \$8

Flor Prosecco, Italy - Flor offers all of the crisp freshness and elegance expected of a great Prosecco. When enjoyed it releases wonderful aromas of ripe pear, melon, a hint of lilies and almonds and smoothly fills the palate with flavors of golden delicious apples and peaches. \$7

Anna Spinato, Prosecco, Italy - This refreshing sparkling wine opens with subtle tones of stone fruit and citrus with subtle sweetness on the close. The quality of the perlage is tight and sharp. \$12

Flor Prosecco Rose, Italy - Flor is a fragrant and refreshing sparkler full of citrus and stone fruit flavors. The bubbles are fine and the mousse is creamy, with a nutty undertone. Flor has just the sort of palate-cleansing acidity you want when eating up things like the melted, gooey, cheesey goodness of raclette. \$7

Cannella Prosecco, Rose, Italy - This wine combines the freshness and fruit of Canella sparkling wines with the seductive appeal of pink and the elegance of time spent on its lees. Light pink in color, its bouquet is floral and appealing, the palate fresh and mellow at the same time. \$11

Anna Blanc de Blanc, Spain - A wine with an intense mouthfeel, notes of ripe and tropical fruit and a fresh zesty finish that creates an overall rounded experience. \$7.50

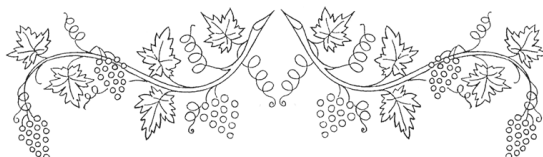
Chandon Brut, California - Crisp and lively, with aromas of green apple, cinnamon and vanilla that lead to appealing flavors of tropical fruit and spicy anise. \$11.75

Chandon Rose, California - A soft rose touched by raspberry flavors, this is generous and juicy in the middle, cut by a sharp acidity in the finish. It hints at the scent of pressed flowers. \$11.75

Mumm Brut Cordon Rouge, France - Expressive nose mingling a fruity note with a slightly toasted biscuity touch. Supple, melted attack, small bubbles, long-lasting freshness. A classic-style, well-made dry sparkler. \$19

Nicolas Feuillatte, France - Lemon zest, white pepper and a touch of mint on the nose. Dry and spicy, with citrus and quince flavors. On the tart side, with the white pepper note repeating on the nervy finish. \$27

Billecart Salmon Brut Reserve, France - A vibrant, well-knit version, lacy in texture and offering an appealing mix of juicy, fresh-cut apple, pear tart, pickled ginger, honey and lemon flavors. \$30

“Champagne for Two or Two Flutes For You” - 375 ml

Gruet Blanc De Noirs NV, American - Pale Salmon in color, our Blanc de Noirs has aromas of raspberry and cherry, complimented by a rich, round mouth feel on the palate and a balance of crispness and toastiness. \$18

Paul Bara Rose, France - 80% pinot noir and 20% chardonnay, all from Bouzy. Sappy and harmonious, with impressive vivacity and purity to its red fruit and floral pastille flavors. Strong mineral and peppery spice notes add complexity to the impressively persistent and focused finish which is shows elegance and precision. \$65

Moet Nectar Imperial Rose, France - A fresh rose, displaying flavors of raspberry, fig, tangy cherry and smoke, with well-integrated acidity. Focused and harmonious, with a spiced, lip-smacking finish. \$55

Billecart Salmon Rose, France - This is clearly one of the great rosé Champagnes distinguished by a freshness and clarity in the wine, from its light pink color to crisp acidity and minerally. It's full-bodied and dense yet agile with amazing length and beauty. Refreshing and vibrant. \$60

Veuve Fourny Blanc de Blancs "Brut Nature "NV, France - This Blanc de Blancs is almost totally dry, yet there is not a trace of austerity. Light yellow in color, it has a gorgeous perfume of citrus and spice with a faint floral mineral undertone. Elegant and finesseful, yet also flavorful and complex. \$40

Veuve Fourny Blanc de Blancs NV, France - Aromas of white peach, under ripe pear, and lemon pith with chalky minerals. Dense and powerful but at the same time taut, with fresh citrus and pit fruit flavors sharpened by zesty acidity and a mineral element. Finishes with a whiplash of tangy citrus and mineral notes. \$40

Moet Blanc de Blanc Ruinart, France - White flower and pear aromas offer a wine that is mineral, nervy, vibrating with the freshest white fruits and lemon juice. It is concentrated, showing strong signs of toast, mature flavors, while keeping great richness. \$72

Veuve Fourny Extra Dry NV, France - A lovely round balance between Premier Cru Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, this is a rich and fruit-ripe champagne. Enjoy it with fruit pies. For those sweet moments. \$38

Paul Bara Brut Reserve "Grand Cru 100%", France - Made from hand picked Chardonnay grapes with no added dosage. A very pure wine and perfect with food. \$42

Paul Bara Brut "Grand Cru" 100% 2005, France - The Paul Bara Brut non-vintage is a terrific bottle of bubbly, with excellent complexity on both the nose and palate and a very elegant and refined mouth feel. On the palate the wine is fullish, crisp and focused, with excellent mid-palate depth, very refined mousse, bright acids and really outstanding length and grip on the complex finish. \$52

Perrier Jouet Grand Brut - This champagne is vibrant with crisp green apple and citrus flavors on the palate. A perfect balance between the acidity and the delicate bubbles, giving it an amazing length. \$54

Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label - The predominance of Pinot Noir provides the structure typical in a Clicquot, while a touch of Pinot Meunier rounds out the blend. Chardonnay adds the elegance and finesse essential in a perfectly balanced wine. Hints of blackberry, white cherry, biscuit, honey and candied lemon zest. \$69

Veuve Clicquot Demi Sec - Boasting a brilliant yellow color with deep golden highlights, this wine offers delicate bubbles and an intense nose of ripe fruit with hints of brioche. It is supple and full on the palate, while preserving its delightful, inherent freshness. After cellaring for two to three years, the Demi-Sec will take on even richer notes of praline. \$73

J Wine Sparkling Brut Cuvee, California - Crisp with acidity and yeasty on the palate with a sourdough tartness, this is a polished bubbly with interesting flavors of limes and strawberries. \$48

One Hope Brut , Rainbow Glitter Edition, California - Displays aromas of fresh green apple and nectarine with a hint of fresh baked bread. Crisp, intriguing fresh fruit reminiscent of succulent peach, sweet berries and pear linger on the palate, finishing with creamy and refreshing bubbles. Every purchase helps fund The Trevor Project's lifeline, which provides crisis intervention and suicide prevention services to LGBTQ youth. \$130

Mercat Brut Cava, Spain -The palate is nicely balanced with subtle citrus notes complemented by dried apricot and a touch of quince. It leads to a precise finish that could do with more length, but it is still an interesting Cava, one that is full of personality. \$19

Flama d'Or Cava Semi-Sec, Spain - Accentuated aroma of fresh grapes, with signs of ripe fruit and citric fruits, very pleasant and characteristic of ageing in the bottle. Aftertaste is fruity, evoking the apple, pear and a hint of citric. Balanced fruity and persistent. \$27

Flor Prosecco Brut, Italy - Flor offers all of the crisp freshness and elegance expected of a great Prosecco. It releases wonderful aromas of ripe pear, melon, a hint of lilies and almonds with flavors of golden delicious apples and peaches. \$23

Flor Prosecco Rose, Italy - Crisp freshness and elegance expected of a great Prosecco. It releases wonderful aromas of ripe pear, melon, a hint of lilies and almonds and smoothly fills the palate with flavors of golden delicious apples and peaches. \$23

Nicolas Feuillatte Rose, France - Light-bodied and fresh, this open-knit rosé shows subtle notes of strawberry, almond biscotti and candied lemon zest, with a chalk-tinged finish. \$78

Moet Ruinart NV Brut Rose, France - A pretty rosé, harmonious and lithe, with flavors of dried strawberry and smoke and intermingling with the accents of toasted almond, ground anise, pastry and dried apricot. Fresh and focused, \$149

Mumm Brut Cordon Rouge, France - A very harmonious dry Champagne, which is full of flavor—dried apricot, candied orange peel, nut and smoke—but still elegant and light-weight. The rich, toasty note lingers on the vibrant finish. \$96

Nicholas Fueilleatte Brut, France - The Number 1 selling Champagne in France 40% pinot noir, 40% pinot meunier and 20% chardonnay. Bright gold with aromas and flavors of orange zest, yellow apple and melon, along with a subtle yeasty overtone. \$75

Moet Nectar Imperial Brut, France - Lively and generous Nectar Impérial distinguishes itself by its tropical fruitiness, its richness on the palate and its crisp finish, that instantly surprise and delight. \$90

Gerard Bertrand Cremant, France - The Chenin and Chardonnay grapes bring texture and balance. Aromatic nose revealing hints of white flower, with hints of honey, green apple and toast. Crisp, elegant structure on the palate. \$24

Moet & Chandon Imperial, France - This spectacular wine replaces White Star as the flag bearer for the brand. It is smooth textured with graceful structure, bright acidity and showing long, precise and vivid flavors. \$64

Perrier-Jouet Grand Brut, France - Elegant and finely balanced, with a subtle vein of smoky minerality underscoring juicy poached apple, candied lemon zest, gingersnap and honey notes. A fine aperitif. \$86

Taittingers Brut, France - Attractive golden hue. Refined, expressive nose suggestive of brioche and almond. The palate shows Seductive fullness, mellowness and creamy texture yet also freshness underpinning the whole. \$106

Duval Leroy Brut, France - Fresh and delicate acidity with a subtle flavor range, including rich hints of toasted brioche, blackberry, honey, lemon zest and smoked almond. A fine aperitif in terms of weight and balance, but in a slightly richer style. \$55

Veuve Fournay Blanc de Blanc, France - Only pure hand-picked Chardonnay from Vertus Premier Cru in this great Cuvée: liveliness and purity, finesse and elegance. \$75

Billecart Salmon Vintage Extra Brut 2006 Grand Cru Reserve, France - The wine reveals an excellent up-front intensity in it's ripe yellow fruit and broad shoulder frame with deep aromatic and flavor complexity. \$115

Krug Grand Cuvee, France - Deep golden color and fine, vivacious bubbles, predicting fullness and elegance. Aromas of flowers in bloom, ripe and dried fruit, marzipan, gingerbread and citrus fruits. Flavors of hazelnut, nougat, barley sugar, jellied and citrus fruits, almonds, brioche and honey. \$340

Roederer Cristal, France -Fantastic from the start. A colossal power of beautiful rumbling Pinot maturity. It's like chewing on the ripest grapes from Ay and Verzenay. At the same time ultra stylish: unmistakable Cristal essence of peach and mango sweetness, pineapple, coconut, vanilla, sprightly acidity and citrus blossom. \$423

Billecart Salmon Brut Reserve, France - A vibrant, well-knit version, lacy in texture and offering an appealing mix of juicy, fresh cut apple, pear tart, pickled ginger, honey and lemon flavors. \$75 Magnum 1.5 L - \$109 Jeroboam 3L—\$218

Dom Perignon, France - Another masterpiece created by Richard Geoffroy. Unmistakable Dom Perignon style with unequalled silkiness throughout the palate. The mousse is worthy of its own chapter and the elegance is striking. Nice minerality and floral notes with citrus overtones. \$360 Magnum \$1,200

Fresh Wines From The Tap

Lioco Carignan - This is an old-timey, "heritage-wine" that harkens back to pre-prohibition days. Featuring a nearly extinct (in California), yet once prolific grape called Carignan, it hits similar notes as the classic bistro wines of Europe such as Beaujolais, Cotes du Rhone, and Dolcetto. \$9

Ryder Cabernet - Full-bodied and elegant, with aromas of black currants and dark cherries accented by hints of chocolate and vanilla. Bright flavors of blackberries and blueberries create a lush mid-palate and the soft tannins lead into a smooth, savory finish. \$9

Altos Las Hormigas Malbec - Rich yet nicely cut, with fresh acidity and fine tannins supporting tasty wild berry and currant notes that expand with hints of underbrush and spice. \$9

Francis Coppola Chardonnay - The perfect balance of sweet, luscious fruit and crisp natural acidity make this a standout wine. \$9

J Pinot Gris - This wine truly represents some of the best California locations for Pinot Gris. This Pinot Gris has an enticing bouquet of apricot and tropical/pineapple fruit. The crisp, lush mouthfeel is also bursting with flavors of lemon and lime and finishes with a distinct minerality on the palate. A hint of kiwi and sweet orange blossom honey on the palate complements the fruit and acid. \$9

Francis Coppola Pinot Noir - Magenta in color. Aromas of plum, cherries, rose petals and cloves. It's not only fragrant, but also luscious on the palate with a long, intense finish. Flavors of raspberries, strawberries and vanilla toasted oak. \$9

CURTAIN CALL's BYZANTINE SANGRIA

Full-bodied red wine infused with the fresh and clean taste of infused peaches strawberries, apple cider, orange juice, bada bing cherry juice, tawny port and soda. \$9

Steele Pinot Noir, California - This soft and supple wine offers notes of meaty red cherry, strawberry, raspberry and pomegranate. *Glass \$10 Bottle \$40*

Erath Pinot Noir, Oregon - Wafts of red plum and raspberry intertwine with spice. The palate flavors of juicy Bing cherry. Try this with the margherita flatbread. *Bottle \$37*

Elk Cove Pinot Noir, Oregon - Bright and tangy with racy citrus, silky texture and crisp acidity; fresh, smooth, lifted and minerally; lots of balance and style. *Glass \$13 Bottle \$51*

Paul Hobbs Felino Cabernet, Argentina - An exquisitely balanced cabernet sauvignon highlighted by its spicy and fruity character and intense ruby red color. Great freshness and intensity. *Glass \$9 Bottle \$33*

Liberty School Cabernet, California - Smooth and juicy with red plum, tangy raspberry and spice; lively, long and balanced with good length and style. *Glass \$10 Bottle \$35*

Robert Craig Affinity Cabernet, California 375 - The Cabernet Sauvignon Affinity has an inky purple color that is much more saturated than its two predecessors. This is a richer style of wine with much greater density, power and intensity. Opaque to the rim with more tannin, extract and muscle. *Bottle \$56*

Joseph Carr Cabernet, California - Full-bodied with food-friendly acidity, flavors of nutmeg, clove, and cinnamon add complexity to the finish. *Glass \$12 Bottle \$44*

Hess Artezin Red Zinfandel, California - Juicy, ripe with tangy acidity and gobs of black raspberry; vibrant, fresh and clean with long, zesty fruit. *Glass \$9 Bottle \$32*

Rosenblum Petite Syrah Heritage Clone, California - Dark purple depths relinquish layers of brooding, black fruits and sultry spices in the 2011 Heritage Clones Petite Sirah. The wine shows its signature gaminess and earthy spices but the cool conditions of the vintage allow the fruit to share the stage, with an upfront juiciness and rich layers of blackberry, cassis and cherry jam. Notes of soy, cocoa and fresh nutmeg join the fruit from the nose all the way through the back of the palate. *Glass \$9 Bottle \$34*

Stag's Leap Petit Syrah, California - With its rich core of blackberry, lavender and pepper spice, this Napa Valley Petite Syrah displays the plush elegance. *Bottle \$65*

Seven Falls Merlot, Washington - Expressive spicy blackberry, currant and licorice flavors. Savoury, meaty mocha and dark chocolate on this nose of this delicious and full-bodied Washington state Merlot. Supple and smooth. Soft jazz, easy-listening red wine. Great with our brisket sliders. *Glass \$7 Bottle \$25*

Dona Paula Malbec, Argentina - A gorgeous and rich red with lots of finesse. Aromas of ripe fruit, terra-cotta, fig and hints of tar. Full-bodied, yet reserved with a very long and intense finish. *Bottle \$39*

Opus One, California - This is very aromatic and pretty with plum, cherry and currant aromas, plus hints of chocolate. It's full-bodied, with soft, silky tannins and a clean, fresh finish. This is a subtly fruity, juicy red with a pretty texture. *Bottle \$375*



White Wines by the Bottle and Glass

Foris Moscato, Oregon - Classic *Oregon* Pinot Gris, fizzy and fruity sweet version of Italy's famous Moscato d'Asti. Peaches, pineapple and lovely freshness go perfectly with fruit tarts, cheeses & dried fruit, or also try as a light lunch beverage. *Glass \$7 Bottle \$26*

Teldeschi White Zinfandel, California - A well balance zin that is tasty with a strong strawberry essence. *Glass \$6 Bottle \$22*

Leitz Dragonstone Reisling, Germany - Fruity honeyed notes to the peach, apple and pear tart flavors that is medium bodied with vibrant acidity, balanced fruit in a slightly off-dry style. Flavors of lemon curd, apple and honeysuckle, moderate length and a clean finish. *Glass \$8.50 Bottle \$32*

Marco Felluga Pinot Grigio 2013, Italy –Floral notes on the nose, combined with notes of apple and citrus. Elegant mouthfeel, nice body and structure with a long, fruity finish. *Glass \$9 Bottle \$32*

Boxler Pinot Grigio 2012, France - One of the world's great Pinot Grigios pairs well with smoke salmon and hard cheeses. *Bottle \$69*

Foris Gewurztraminer, Oregon - Smooth and supple on the palate, sweet raspberry and cherry flavors and a hint of white pepper. Closes with good tangy lift and cut, with no obvious tannins and good, spicy persistence. *Glass \$7 Bottle \$23*

Josh Cellars Savignon Blanc, California - Bright aromas of lime and citrus with layers of white flower nectar, peach, and tropical melon. Clean fruit flavors and a perfectly balanced finish. *Glass \$8 Bottle \$32*

Domain Dureuil Janthal Rully Blanc Chardonnay, France - This "wine has all the complexity of a premier cru yet is still a value in white Burgundy. A stony, crisp nose makes way for a supple and juicy middle of white fruits and citrus zest, perfectly poised and balanced. The crisp, long finish is lively with plenty of white pepper. Vincent blends four different vineyard plots for this wine. *Glass \$18 Bottle \$89*

La Crema Chardonnay Russian River, California - Full of ripe pear, quince and nutmeg aromas, and follows with flavors of lemon tart, Marzipan, apricot and nougat. Rich and layered with sweet spice, balanced integrated acidity. *Glass \$14 Bottle \$55*

Jayson Pahlmeyer Chardonnay 2012, California - An alluring nose of vanilla, lime, mineral, toasted grain and licorice. The palate is silky on entry with coconut, vanilla blossoms and lychee with bright and sculpted pear and stone fruit in the core. Nice acidity. *Bottle \$86*

Far Niente Chardonnay, California - This wine offers lively aromas of lemon and lime citrus zest, honeydew melon, wet stone and honeysuckle blossom. Bright upon entry with a silky texture through the mid-palate, the wine is focused and long with citrus and mineral flavors supported by integrated notes of oak. The finish is clean and refreshing. *Bottle \$97*

Gerard Bertrand Gris Blanc Rose, France - The bouquet reveals delightful red berry scents. A slight sparkle on the palate gives the wine all its freshness and bring out the fullness of fruit. Grenache is the king of grape varieties when it comes to making light, racy, fruity rosés in contemporary style. Grenache Its fig and sometimes cocoa flavors, coupled with rounded sensations on the palate, make Grenache one of the great varieties of the South of France. *Glass \$7 Bottle \$24*
